Directions for the referring agent:

All families with children receiving treatment at area hospitals and clinics are eligible to stay at the Ronald McDonald House of Mid-Michigan based on room availability and regardless of financial resources. Priority will be given to families more than 30 minutes away from home. Families who live less than 30 minutes are welcome to stay at the House based on availability. However, they may be asked to relinquish their room for a family that is more than 30 minutes away from home.

DETERMINE PRIORITIES:

- 1. Families of patients hospitalized In an intensive care unit or in the Inpatient Children’s Center
2. Patients/families who arrive the day before admission
3. Patients/families receiving outpatient treatment
4. Pregnant mothers that are treated as outpatients
5. Adoptive parents awaiting the delivery of a baby to be placed in RNICU

5. Children (under 18) staying at the House must be supervised by an adult at all times.
